Registration Dates: Men's & Women's: March 20th (Monday) – March 26th (Sunday)

Co-Rec: March 27th (Monday) - April 2nd (Sunday)

Playing Dates: Men's & Women's: April 2nd (Sunday)

Co-Rec: April 9th (Sunday)

Playing Time: Matches begin at 11:00AM. Arrive early to sign-in.

FORMAT: The exact tournament format will depend on the number of teams that register. All matches will be played on the **varsity tennis courts** located on North Hillside Road (before Charter Oak Apartments).

FORFEIT PROCEDURE:

1. If a team fails to have the required number of participants at the scheduled game time, the opposing team who is present will automatically win the game by forfeit. The captain of the forfeited team will be charged a \$25 fee on their University fee bill.
2. If a team chooses to withdraw from the tournament for any reasons after the schedule has been posted on IMLeagues, the captain will be charged the \$25 forfeit fee.

EQUIPMENT:

1. Participants must bring their own racquets.
2. Balls will be provided.
3. Only sneakers will be allowed.

SCORING: The team that wins eight games first, wins the match (pro-set).

* Other game rules will follow NCAA Tennis Rules.

* You may enter as many teams (with the same name) as you want. However, only the top four teams (for each team with the same name) in each division will receive All-Campus Championship Points.

SPORTSMANSHIP RATING: Good sportsmanship is required of all participants. Players, coaches, and spectators are to conduct themselves properly at all times. UConn Recreation reserves the right to suspend or disqualify groups or individuals for unsportsmanlike conduct at any time. Unsportsmanlike conduct before, during, and/or after a game (event) will not be tolerated.
