

**NOTE:** Rules are governed by World ParaVolley Official Sitting Volleyball Rules with the following adaptations. For a complete list of general Intramural Sports Policies, please reference the participants guide at recreation.uconn.edu or on IMLeagues.

**FORMAT:** This is a 6 player tournament. The exact tournament format will depend on the number of teams that register. The games will be played in Guyer Gym located in the Student Recreation Facility.

**ROSTERS:** Teams must have a full roster by the end of registration in order to be entered into the tournament.

Roster additions must be completed through IMLeagues by 4:00PM on the day of the tournament. No roster additions will be allowed at the game site.

**FORFEIT PROCEDURE:** If a team fails to have the required number of participants at the scheduled game time, the opposing team who is present will automatically win the game by forfeit. The team who forfeited may remain eligible for the remainder of the tournament depending on the tournament format. However, the captain of the forfeited team will be charged a \$25 fee on their University fee bill. Captains who withdraw from the tournament after registration may also be charged a \$25 forfeit fee on their University fee bill.

**GAME RULES:**

1. **SCORING:** All games will use rally point scoring. No cap, win by two. A match consists of best 2 out of 3 games. Games may be shortened depending on the format of the tournament
2. Each team must start the game with six players. Teams may finish with less due to an injury or other reasons.
3. Substitutions are allowed when the ball is dead. Unlimited substitutions are allowed for a team, however each entry must be to the same position in the service order.
4. Libero will not be used.

**ADDITIONAL RULES:**

1. At all times during playing actions the players must contact the court with some part of the body between the buttocks and shoulders. Lifting is permitted in the back zone when playing the ball in a defensive action if the contact is made when the ball is not entirely higher than the top of the net. Failing to maintain contact with the court will result in a violation, a point and the serve being awarded to the opposing team.
